## High School and U19 Divisional Structure *Spring 2011 Competitive Season*

### Competition Frameworks and Requirements

- All member clubs of MYRO must have completed team applications on file as well as be current in MYRO dues and be USA Rugby CIPP compliant.
- Each team must play all other teams in its division (DI, Community Clubs) or conference (DII) at least once in a home or away format. Open dates may be used to schedule cross-divisional matches.
- Division standings will be based on a team's win-loss-tie record within its respective division. Ties in standings at the end of the season will be decided by head-to-head results.
- All schedules are to be made coach-to-coach and must be submitted to the appropriate director before the start of the competitive season.
- Match results are to be reported by the home team within 24 hours of the completion of the match. The MYRO website, MYRugby.org, will have a link available for match reporting.
- All matches leading to a state tournament seeding must be completed a minimum of 5 calendar days before the first day of tournament play.
- Home teams are to request referees from NERRS in a timely manner as dictated by the referee society.
- Cancellations of matches should be managed between the coaches involved. All attempts should be made to reschedule when possible. Cancelled matches must be reported to the appropriate director within 24 hours of cancellation and before the match had been scheduled to be played.
- Matches between MYRO clubs and non-MYRO clubs are at the discretion of the individual coaches and school and club administrations. Matches played outside of MYRO will not count towards state standings and tournament seedings. **All MYRO member clubs are to follow USA Rugby and IRB regulations regarding player eligibility, USA Rugby memberships, and insurance when playing matches against non-member clubs.**
- **State Tournament:** The top team from each division 2 conference will play a complete match to crown the D2 regular-season champion. The remaining D2 teams and all other divisions will play within their division in shortened tournament matches to name Tournament Champions from each division
